It has a 3-foot handle and weighs about 8 pounds. A still heavier wrecking-bar with a 4-foot handle, the total weight of which is 14 pounds, is also made by this company, and is known as its NO. 3 bar. This is used for pulling off heavy braces and for the harder work of wrecking buildings and taking down concrete forms. The projecting lug furnishes a solid pry for the 10 to 1 leverage of this bar....
